Call to Order

Mayor Julie Smith called the meeting to order at 12:00 PM.

Resolution Approving Forms Pertaining to the Delivery and Funding of Certain Services Pursuant to the Service Delivery Act


Mayor Smith briefly overviewed and informed the public present on the importance and purpose of Service Delivery. Mayor Smith briefly reviewed the negotiation timeline between the City and County which began in October 2017 and in which the formal update is due to the state by June 30, 2018. Mayor Smith mentioned the City and County have agreed on some service delivery updates, but there are still pending issues which need to be resolved. The remaining service delivery issues which have not been agreed upon include: Animal Control, E-911, EMA, Mosquito Control, Fire, Solid Waste Collection, Developmental Support Services, Zoning and Water.

Mayor Smith mentioned the City has prepared a letter to Tift County with options for resolving the pending service delivery issues and the proposed resolution being discussed today will accompany the letter. Mr. Wilmot mentioned the resolution being presented acknowledges the importance of Ruth's Cottage and the Patticake House and their services, and provides for an amendment to the current Service Delivery Strategy to include Transitional Housing as provided by Ruth's Cottage to the current service delivery strategy, but doesn't extend the entire SDS for another 10 year period. Council discussed the Service Delivery issues and the need for submitting an accurate SDS update to the state by the June 30 deadline. After review and discussion of the resolution, Council Member Jack Folk made the first motion for approval of the resolution, motion seconded by Terrell, and unanimously approved.


Planning a Joint Meeting to Discuss the Service Delivery Update
