Mayor Julie Smith thanked the staff for their recent hospitality, planning, and hard work in the City's Hometown Connection Event.

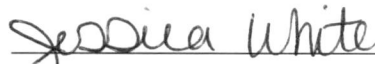
Council Member Jack Folk expressed condolences to Jessica White and her family during their time of loss of a family member.
