City Manager Report

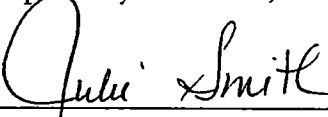

Board Report

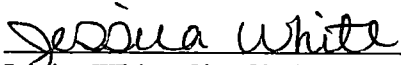
