May 19th, 2022

A public hearing meeting of the Town of Timberville Council was held Thursday May 19th, 2022 at 7:00 p.m. in the Town’s council chambers with Mayor Donald Delaughter presiding.

PUBLIC HEARING: Mayor Delaughter started the public hearing at 7:00 p.m. Town Manager Austin Garber explained that due to Rockingham County’s real estate assessment increase, an increase in revenue, of more than 1%, you have to lower the tax rate or have a public hearing. He states that the Council has chosen to do both. It is currently proposed to lower the tax rate from 11.5 cents per 100 to 10.5 cents per hundred. Mayor Delaughter opened for public comment. Receiving no public comment, Mayor Delaughter closed the public comment section. Clarence Fox made a motion to lower the tax rate to 10.5 cents. Debbie Jessup seconded the motion.
