Taxes are payable to the Tax Collector at the Tax Collector's Office, Town Hall, 195 Danielson Pike, PO Box 328, Scituate, Rhode Island 02857.

The tax rate for residential real estate is \$16.76 each \$1,000 at 100% assessment ratio; for commercial/industrial/mixed use including utility is \$24.56 each \$1,000 at 100% assessment ratio; and for tangible personal property is \$35.68 each \$1,000. The tax rate on retail and wholesale inventory is exempt by State Law and by the Scituate Town Council. The current rate is apportioned as follows:

School Purposes	64.4%
Municipal Purposes	<u>35.6%</u>

The Town Council has presented a 15-month budget for Fiscal year 2024. The voters approved said budget at the Annual Financial Town Meeting held on April 4, 2023. Fiscal year 2024 will commence April 1, 2023, and end on June 30, 2024. The purpose of this extended fiscal year is to align the town's fiscal year with the State. Thereafter, the town fiscal year will commence July 1 and end June 30<sup>th</sup>. In fiscal year 2024 there will be five tax installments due as follows:

All taxes are due and payable July 1, 2023, and on and after August 1, 2023, draw interest from July 1, 2023, until paid at the rate of 9 per centum per annum, as a penalty. (See schedule for installment payments.

STATE OF RHODE ISLAND AND PROVIDENCE PLANTATIONS RESOLVED:

Resolved, that the Electors of the Town of Scituate, Rhode Island qualified to vote on any proposition to impose a tax, in the Town Meeting legally assembled on this 4<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 2023 hereby order the assessment and collection of a tax on the ratable real estate and tangible personal property in the sum not less than \$32,369.404 and not more than \$41,667,243 or not more than \$16.76 per thousand for residential property, not more than \$24.56 per thousand for commercial/industrial/mixed use property and not more than \$35.68 for tangible property of assessed valuation. The final levy shall be set based on the amount, if any, of State reimbursement for the motor vehicle excise tax, pursuant to RIGL §44-34.1-2. Said tax is for the ordinary expenses and charges for the payment of interest and indebtedness in whole or in part of said Town, for the payment of the Town's proportion of the State tax and for other purposes authorized by law.

The Tax Assessor shall apportion said tax on the inhabitants and ratable property of said Town as of the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December A.D. 2022 at twelve, midnight, according to law, and shall on completion of said levy, date, certify and sign the same and deliver to and deposit the same in the office of the Town Clerk.

Now, therefore, I the undersigned assessor of taxes of said Town of Scituate, having been duly appointed, sworn and engaged, and having given due notice as the law requires by posting a notice in a local newspaper for three weeks and posting up printed notices thereof in three or more public places in said town for more than three successive weeks next preceding the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January A.D. 2023 (the day appointed in and by said notices for bringing accounts) to wit: in the Town Clerk's Office, North Scituate Post Office, Hope Post Office, and in other places in said Town, did as of the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December A.D. 2022 at twelve o'clock midnight, assess and apportion said tax on the ratable property in said town as hereinbefore written and set forth in the preceding pages of this book, and have this 15<sup>th</sup> day of June A.D. 2023 delivered to and deposited said assessment in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Scituate.




