News

Summer Reading Programs

- **Children's Summer Reading Program**

- This year's Children's Summer Reading Program had the theme of All Together Now! It started on June 26th and ran for eight weeks, ending on August 18th.
- We had four activity trackers with each tracker requiring fifteen activities. After completing a tracker children got a prize pack, meaning rabid readers could win up to four prizes over the summer!



- Each tracker required participants to complete activities from a such as: read for twenty minutes, go for a walk/hike with your family, cook a new recipe or play a board game with your family. Those who completed all four trackers did a total of sixty reading related activities this summer!
- Ninety-six participants signed up for the Children's/Teen Summer Reading Program and thirty fifty-five percent of those who signed up for the Children's/Teen Summer Reading Program earned at least one prize.

- **Adult Summer Reading Program**

- The program ran from June 1st through August 24th and required that participants to read ten total books during this time. As part of the program, we required the Maine Humanities Council Read ME program books to be two of the ten books read.
- Seventy-one people signed up for the program and half completed the program requirements to be eligible for prizes.
- Each participant who completed the program had their names entered to win one of three prizes. Each prize consisted of six regular print books, one large print book, and a gift certificate to a local business. Names were drawn on August 25, 2023 and the winners were notified by a phone call.
