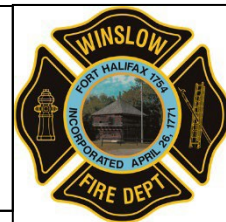

TOWN COUNCIL MONTHLY BRIEFING



Incident Response for December

Total calls for this period were 168. EMS related calls totaled 78 of those calls Winslow transported 54. Fire related calls were 44 (2 structure fire in 1 in Winslow 2 Monument St 1 in China). There were 16 calls for non-emergency service, 10 were for hazardous conditions (flammable liquid spill, down power lines, trees, and car accidents

Mutual Aid calls for December were as follows. Winslow received mutual aid on 9 occasions: In total, Winslow requested 9 paramedic intercepts for the month. Waterville responded to 2 of those paramedic intercepts requested and transported with us for 2 of those. Additionally, we received from Delta 3 paramedic intercepts and transport with us. Winslow provided mutual aid to The Town of China 1 for structure Fire.

Community News

Winslow Fire department contacted Maine EMS asking if we would participate in an EMS Explorer Program. The department also participated in Operation Warmth. The department donated winter jackets at the Winslow school system. They also donated winter jackets to the Mid Maine Homeless Shelter.

Department News

In December we held interviews and a physical assessment for the 2 positions that were vacant. I am pleased to announce that the department made an offer of employment to William Crawford III, and he accepted the job. William is currently training and after his three weeks will be assigned to B shift.

The following is a breakdown of the EMS transport service for the month and for the year to date. There is approximately \$154,000 in accounts receivable currently outstanding. The table below indicates receipts and expenses associated with the service. The monthly expense report was not available at the time of submission.
