## *Incident Response for February 2023*

Total calls for this period were 106. EMS related calls totaled 64 of those calls Winslow transported 41. Fire related calls were 4 (1 structure fire in Waterville, 2 Chimney Fire in Winslow 1 Commercial Compactor fire confined to rubbish). There were 7 calls for non-emergency service, 7 were for hazardous conditions (1 hazardous condition 3 carbon monoxide incidents 1 down power lines, 1 tree down. 18 calls for service. 3 Good intent calls. 1.911 complaint.

Mutual Aid calls for February were as follows. Winslow requested 11 paramedic intercepts for the month. Delta responded to 9 of those requests and had no units available to respond to 2 calls. Waterville Fire provided 2 intercepts. Winslow Fire provided mutual aid 5 times in the month of February 2 for fire related calls and 3 times to cover another station.
