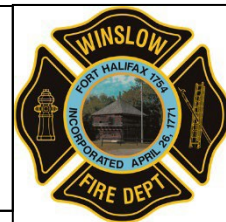

Incident Response for January

Total calls for this period were 126. EMS related calls totaled 103 of those calls Winslow transported 84. Fire related calls were 12 (1 structure fire in 1 in Winslow 1 Chimney Fire Winslow). There were 7 calls for non-emergency service, 1 were for hazardous conditions (flammable liquid spill, down power lines, trees, and car accidents

Mutual Aid calls for January were as follows. Winslow received mutual aid on 1 occasion: In total, Winslow requested 9 paramedic intercepts for the month. Waterville responded to 9 of those paramedic intercepts requested and transported with us for 2 of those. Additionally, we received from Delta 0 paramedic intercepts due to unavailable units. Winslow provided mutual aid to Waterville on 4 occasions.
