It's as simple as 1-2-3!

	<p>FILL IT</p> <p>Put old medication in the bag. Leave them in the original packaging.</p>	<p>DO</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO detach the receipt. Please keep for your records. • DO put unused, legally possessed, medications into the envelope. Controlled (DEA Schedule II-V), non-controlled and over-the-counter pharmaceuticals are okay. • DO Wrap liquids in paper towel and seal in a zip top bag. • DO Limit liquids to 4 ounces. • DO include the provided absorbent sheet in the bag. • DO Seal this envelope completely to mask the contents and stop leaks or spills. 	<p>DON'T</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DON'T mail with receipt attached. • DON'T mail Sharps, like needles, injection pens, syringes, etc. • DON'T mail medical or chemotherapy waste. • DON'T mail Illicit drugs like marijuana, cocaine, heroin, methamphetamine, etc. Any DEA Schedule I Controlled Substance. • DON'T give the filled bag to anyone except an authorized USPS Mail Carrier. • DON'T overfill it. • DON'T use any other packaging or it will be rejected.
	<p>SEAL IT</p> <p>Remove the protective liner strip to expose the adhesive strip and carefully seal the envelope.</p>		
	<p>MAIL IT</p> <p>Drop the envelope in the mail. The postage is free.</p> <p>USE THIS PACKAGE ONLY</p>		
<p>TRACK IT</p> <p>www.MailBackTrack.com</p> <p>Enter the 10 digits on your receipt</p>		<p>INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE</p> <p>EASY AS 1-2-3</p> <p>123CL-LIQ</p>	

***Remember to remove all identifiable information (prescription labels, or materials) before disposing of your medications.**

What can I send? Medications in any dosage for, except those listed below in their original container or sealed bag. If transferring medications to a sealed bag, please be sure to recycle all remaining packaging.

What can't I send? Herbal remedies, vitamins, supplements, cosmetics, other personal care products, inhalers, medical devices, batteries, mercury-containing thermometers, sharps, and illicit drugs.
