Dear Ms. LaCroix:

The Maine Department of Transportation is currently working on estimating a Highway Rehabilitation – CHIP - Collector Highway Improvement Program project on Route 32 in the Towns of Vassalboro and Winslow for advertisement of the subject project for competitive bids in March of 2023. The work will include milling of the existing pavement and placing new pavement, including paving the existing gravel shoulder for an approximate total paved width of 28 feet. Construction will occur during the Summer and Fall; exact start and completion dates will be forwarded once a schedule from the Contractor has been reviewed and approved. After the new pavement is placed, no permit to open this segment of highway will be granted for a period of five (5) except as provided in Title 23, M.R.S.A. §3352.

The project is further described as follows:

*Beginning 0.23 of a mile south of the Winslow town line in Vassalboro and extending north 2.48 miles.*

The purpose of this letter is to make the necessary notifications of the project to abutters, municipal officials and occupants of the highway under the provisions of 23 M.R.S.A. § 3351. We hereby request that you provide a copy of this notice to all municipal officials, employees and boards with responsibilities for utility and/or land-use planning/permitting, and that you post this letter on any municipal public bulletin boards, media outlets and/or municipal websites as public meeting will not be held regarding this project unless specifically requested by the municipality.

The Department would like to know if there are any events or known traffic generators that would impact this project.
