The Winslow Public Library has an opening for a Youth Services Technician. This is a part-time, 20-hr a week position, with some evening and weekend hours required.

The Youth Services Technician works under the general guidance and supervision of the Library Director.

Responsibilities include:

- Programming and outreach services for children and pre-teens.
- Provision of reference & circulation services for the children's area.
- Computer use guidance for young patrons.
- Use of social networking platforms to communicate library services and programs to patrons.
- Supervision of volunteer assistants for youth programs.

Experience working in a library or educational setting, a bachelor's degree, proficiency with technology and experience with children, demonstrated knowledge of current children's education, literature and programming are a priority. Candidates with a combination of comparable education and experience that demonstrates the necessary knowledge, skills, and abilities welcome.

A full job description will be provided on request. Salary for the position is \$15.66 an hour. Winslow participates jointly with employees in Social Security payments.
