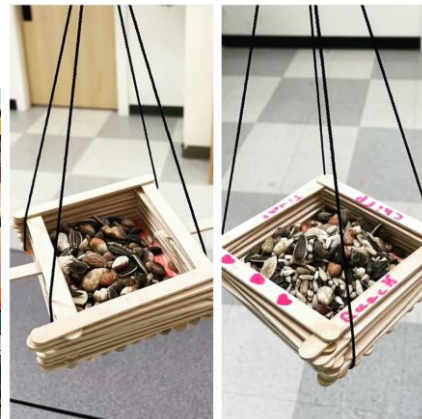


June Parks and Recreation Monthly Report
