
Dear Councilors,

- Police Activity graph for month of January 2021 attached. Total calls for service 632.
- I re-wrote the job description for the Lieutenant position. I made the requirements more realistic and clearer to understand and implement daily. I am looking forward to promoting someone to this position so that we can together move the department in a productive and positive direction.
- I developed a test for the Lieutenant promotion process. This test is composed of 50 questions. This test will help clarify who is ready for the promotion.
