## PRESS RELEASE

Winslow Police Department received a complaint from a Town of Winslow resident regarding a misdelivered package on Friday, May 3, 2024. The package was sent from California and the resident advised that they had not ordered anything nor were they expecting any delivery. The package was subsequently opened, and multiple bags of pills were discovered inside. The pills presumptively tested positive as Fentanyl. A second package containing more pills was delivered on Saturday, May 4, 2023. The total weight of the pills is approximately 29.5 pounds. Typically, the street value of a gram of Fentanyl is between \$150-200, and pills can sell for as much as \$60 each. The potential street value could be up to 2 million dollars.
