Please accept the following report for the month of September 2023.

- Our Police Activity Graph for the month of September 2023 is attached hereto for your review. 729 calls for service were handled during the month.
- We were advised by MMA Risk Management Services that our grant request was approved, and Winslow PD will be awarded \$5,000.00 to be used for the Maine Law Enforcement Accreditation Program (MLEAP) certification process.
- We decommissioned the last Dodge Charger cruiser from our fleet this month. The equipment and vinyl police lettering were removed internally without using an outside vendor, which resulted in cost savings of approximately \$1,000.00.
- Winslow Police Officers are busy completing mandatory trainings required to maintain their certifications for another year with the Maine Criminal Justice Academy.

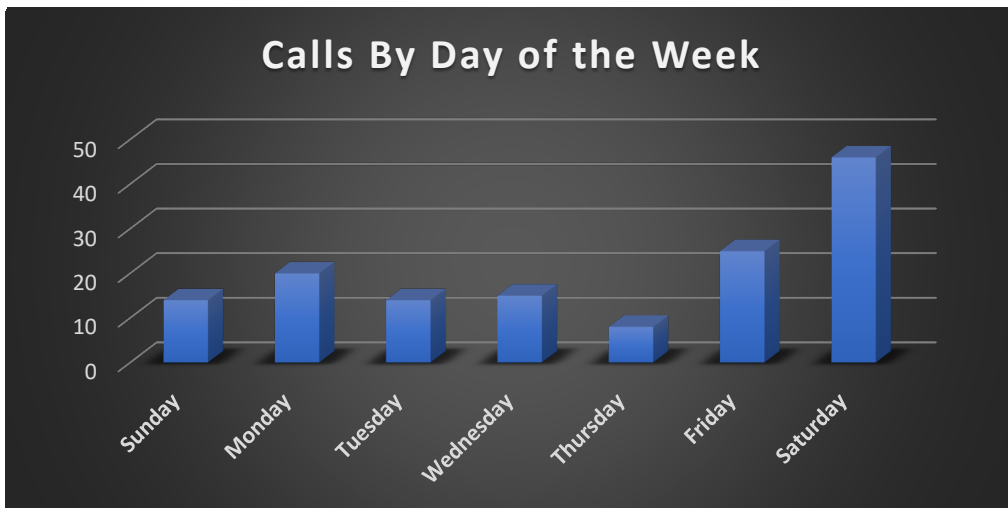
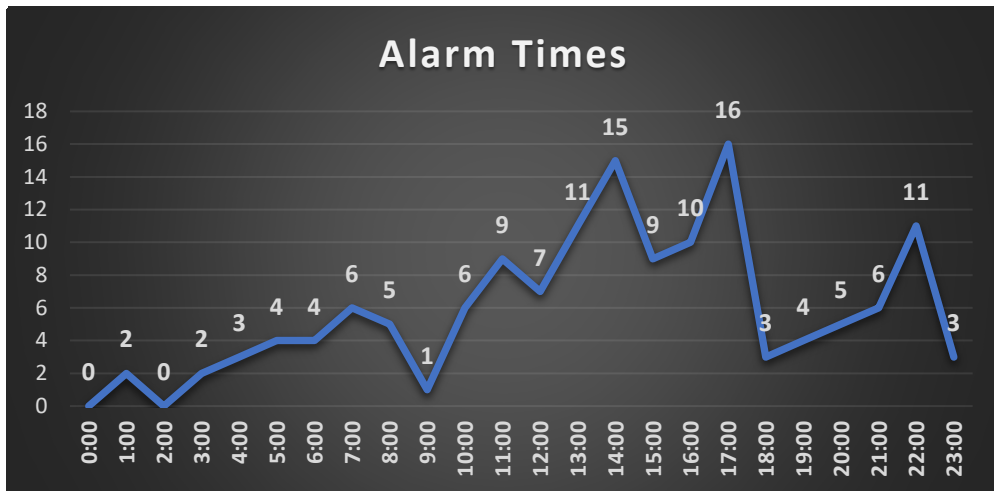
Incident Response for September 2023

September was a fairly busy month, between calls, training and community activities, the members have been non-stop. Total calls for the month were 142, Fire Related 7, EMS related calls 86 with 57 of them being EMS transports.

Mutual Aid calls for September were as follows. Winslow requested 6 paramedic intercepts for the month. Delta was not able to respond to any of those requests as they had no units available. Winslow Fire provided mutual aid 3 times in the month of September 1 for fire related calls, 1 time to cover another station and 1 EMS call.

Special note of having two 2nd alarm structure fires in town. Members of B-shift responded and thanks to adequate staffing levels all essential tasks were safely performed in 20 minutes or less.





Department News

2 Members started schooling towards higher education and medical licensure. Lieutenant Shawn Stetson started Paramedic School and Firefighter Misha Littlefield started school towards his Advanced EMT License. 3 Members started a training class towards becoming Fire Instructors, Captain Jonathan Beringer, Wyatt Oliver and Eric Chamberlain are attending. We wish all members good luck and thanks for continuing to better themselves.

We are currently short-handed in staffing. The Fire Department has one opening for a Firefighter/EMT on A-Shift and one member of C-Shift is currently still out on medical.

We are still in limbo with some of our current grants that we have applied for, we have not received any rejection letters, some neighboring municipalities have already been awarded their assets so we shall wait and see.

The Truck Committee for the new tanker has been in deep discussions and awaiting 1 or 2 more bids to trickle in before we submit and present.

Members have been attending multiple community events including Winslows Homecoming Bonfire as well as staffing and attending multiple Varsity and JV football games and have had many positive interactions with the citizens of Winslow.
