Monthly Report to the Town Manager and Town Council August 2022

Our paving project on Benton Avenue is finally complete. Everything has been paved, striped, and seeded. It was a lengthy project but all the contractors involved did very good work. It should serve the Town well for many years.

All of this year's streets and roads on the paving list are ready for the paving contractor. The North Reynold Road was ditched and most culverts replaced, along with clearing trees in the right-of-way. A section of the Ellis Road was rebased. Lee Street and Beck Street were rebased and 270 feet of storm drain was replaced on Beck Street along with two catch basins. We lowered the manhole covers on Clifford Avenue and it is awaiting to be reclaimed.

Our Chaffee Brook pump station project is moving forward. We have received our two major permits for the river crossing. One from the Department of Environmental Protection and one from the Army Corps of Engineers. We should almost be ready to apply for funding for this project.

On Friday, September 16, the final layer of pavement will be installed at the Town Office. We will let the pavement cure for a couple of weeks before we do the striping.

Finally, one of our two new trucks should be delivered to us this week with the second one to follow shortly. This will allow us to utilize them for hauling winter sand, eliminating the need for hired trucks and will give these new trucks a break-in period before winter starts.
