### Monthly Report to the Town Manager and Town Council      May 2023

The month of May went by quickly. The crew was very busy. In coordination with Pike Industries, all the paving that was held over from last fall has been completed. All the driveway aprons have been paved and gravel has been added to the shoulders on North Reynolds Road and the Ellis Road. The only item remaining is to loam and seed the lawns on Lee, Beck, and Clifford.

We have completed repairing the winter plow damage to private and public property. We are about a week away from completing our street sweeping, We will transition to striping crosswalks and stop bars after this. The rest of the crew will start prepping for this season's paving. We will start clearing the right-of-way on the Shorey Road and the Nowell Road in anticipation of ditching and replacing culverts. I am aiming for paving these two roads in September. The in-town paving will be done in July and August.

On May 22, I attended an all day meeting with CMP management at their headquarters in Augusta. Much of the day was spent discussing storm preparation and response and how we can communicate with them to set priority roads that need to be cleared. They also showed us the control center for all the CMP system. This was quite impressive. It was disappointing to see the turn out from the 39 towns in this service area. We only had 5 or 6 towns represented.

On May 17, Trevor Tucker completed the last class in the Supervisory Leadership program he had been enrolled in. Congratulations to Trevor for completing the course.

On June 1<sup>st</sup>, we received bids for replacement pickups. We are still evaluating the results.
