Monthly Report to the Town Manager and Town Council September 2022

Our two new plow trucks have finally been delivered and are now on the road hauling winter sand. They should serve the community well for many years to come. Thank you to the Town Council and Town Manager for your support.

We paved the wearing surface on the Town Office parking lot on September 16. As soon as the crew is finished hauling winter sand, we will stripe the parking lot.

Our crews have completed most of the projects planned for this season. They replaced two failing catch basins and have three new ones to install if time permits. As soon as our paving contractor, Pike Industries, comes in to install base pavement on Clifford, Beck, and Lee Streets, we will have to go raise the sewer and storm drain covers to grade before the final surface is installed. The crew was able to shim some rough areas with hot mix on Smiley Ave., Frawley, Patterson, and Shorey Road.

On this month's agenda is an order authorizing the Chaffee Brook Pump Station project. We have our major permits and this is the next step in applying for funding. The project needs formal Council approval to move forward.

In closing, a reminder that our annual Hazardous Household Waste collection day is coming up on Saturday, October 15, 2022, from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm.
