Monthly Report to the Town Manager and Town Council November 2023

On November 6, we returned to our winter schedule of 5 - eight hour days. We keep this schedule until the second Monday in April. As usually, we also assisted the Town Clerk with election set-up and take down for the November elections at the VFW.

The storm drain project on the China and Cushman Road is finally picking up speed. They have cleared the China Road and have made it to Belanger Street. The trench on the China Road has been paved and the curbing replaced. In the spring, they will mill the China Road and re-surface. The disturbed sidewalk in front of Cumberland Farms and McDonalds will be paved in the spring.

Our contractor on the force main river crossing is also doing well. They have completed all the necessary work on the Waterville side to tie in the new force mains to the existing interceptor. They have completed the trench across from Waterville to Winslow and have begun fusing the new force main together. The tentative schedule, weather permitting, is to be done installing pipe in the river bed before Christmas.

Finally, on November 25, we participated in the annual Christmas Parade of Lights. One of my employees, Justin Vigue, decorated his plow truck with lights and presents. It looked awesome and we received a lot of positive comments. Great job Justin. Thank you.
