Please accept the following report for October.

- Police Activity Graph for the month of October 2022. Total calls for service 934.
- I attended the IACP in Dallas, taking part in a variety of classes on several topics which will help better prepare the police department for the upcoming challenges we will encounter next year in a volatile environment.
- See enclosed letter from ADA Amanda Seekins regarding the excellent work and arrest from Officer Randy Wing on an important case.
- On 10/17/22 Sergeant Brandon Lund completed the pepper ball instructor training course. He will now be able to train other officers in-house, which will be a cost savings for the town.
- Lieutenant Brad Hubert completed an active shooter webinar on 10/19/22 with the school system.
- Dispatcher Teresa Crawford completed terminal operator recertification on 10/20/22.
- All Officers completed the national EVOC intersection training.
- On Friday 10/28/22 and on Sunday 10/30/22 several officers took part in trunk or treat. This was a great community policing activity which was well attended by parents and children.
- We had a major drug bust on 11/01/22 which was a direct result of three burglaries, officers then recovered a large amount of stolen property, and two individuals were arrested. Mardens (surplus and salvage) was burglarized on three separate occasions. The night officer arrested two suspects at 3:AM in the morning while the crime was taking place. In a joint effort with the Somerset Sheriff's Office, a warrant was executed in Anson, where a large number of drugs and stolen property were taken into police custody.
