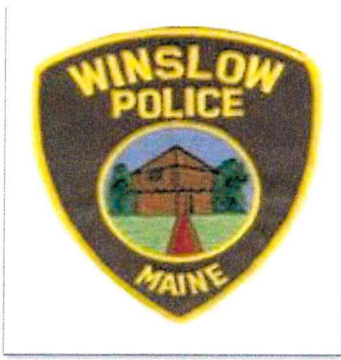
Please accept the following report for July
