### Summary:

On Sunday 08/21/22 at 6:02 PM Winslow PD got a report of an armed robbery that just occurred on the Abbott RD. The suspects fled the scene in a vehicle prior to Officers arriving.

The victim, the suspect and a female all arrived at the crime scene together. The suspect pointed a handgun at the victim and ordered him out of the car. Once outside of the vehicle, the suspect had the victim remove his clothing. He then fired the weapon and assaulted him causing facial injuries. The suspect left with an undisclosed amount of cash. The victim was transported to Inland Hospital in Waterville for his injuries. He was released that night.

On 08/24/22 at 10:30 AM Dustin was arrested by the State Police at his workplace in Waterville without incident. He was transported to Winslow PD to be processed. He was the taken to KSO jail in Augusta.
