Please accept the following report for November.

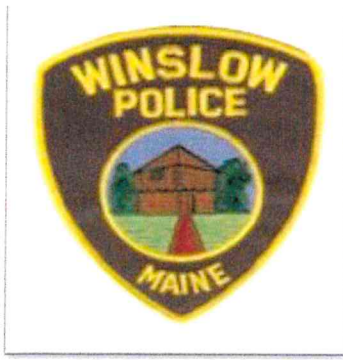
- Police Activity Graph for the month of November 2022. Total calls for service 906.
- On Friday 11/04/22 Lt. Hubert and Officer Poulin visited the Happy Day Care. They were met with smiles from young children. Pictures of the visit were put on the Police Facebook page.
- Several Officers including myself provided security at the voting booths on Tuesday 11/08/22.
- On 11/15/22 most school systems across the state received emergency calls regarding an active shooter in the school. Winslow also received such a call. I credit the experience of our dispatcher Teresa Crawford who quickly accessed the call and with direct questions determined that it was not an active threat. All officers working at the time worked with school officials to quiet the hoax.
- On Wednesday 11/23/22 and Friday 12/02/22 myself, Lt Hubert and IFC Bolduc met for the first time regarding the PS department. We had a very productive meeting planning the best route forward, for the next six months, to get an accurate assessment of the current needs of both departments. I have also spent a considerable amount of time talking to all employees seeking input and ideas. Together, I believe we will be able to make a fair recommendation to the councilors after the trial period ends.
- Both Officer Jonathan Chasse and Ben Loubier have been accepted to the MCJA this year for the academy starting at the end of December. It will be a struggle to lose both officers at the same time, but this will allow us to be at full-staff next summer.
- Several members of the Police and Fire departments took part in the yearly parade of lights on Saturday 11/26/22. It was a huge success and I personally found it fun. We had one complaint which will be addressed next year.
