

# **TRC Reopening Plan**

We are following Wyandotte County's adoption of the State of Kansas Guidelines for reopening. Each phase is labeled below. Below is the plan put in place based off those phases. When we refer to ppe below, that means Personal Protective Equipment (Masks, gloves, etc.) The situation will continue to be closely monitored throughout these phases. #### Phase III - Will open no earlier than June 1

#### **Parks**

- Our Parks will open back up.
  - o The playground and fitness center equipment will be open for use.
  - Please continue to practice social distancing and use of ppe.
  - All equipment will be sprayed everyday.

#### **Recreation Center**

- Our Recreation Center will open with limited amenities.
  - o Building will open at 9 and close at 6, M-F only. Weekends will be closed.
  - o Only the front entrance will be open. All other side doors will remain closed and locked.
    - All Patrons needing to access our building will be required to use a face mask, before they can enter the building.
    - All patrons will be required to take their temperature by a TRC Staff employee before entering the building
    - All patrons will then be required to sign a waiver form as well as supply contact information and reason for business
  - o The Fitness center will open
    - Between 9-6 only
    - (4) limited capacity in each 1-hour rotation
    - All Patrons using the fitness center will be required to wear ppe and maintain social distancing at all times.
    - The Fitness Center will be open in a first come first serve basis: 1-hour rotations except last half hour of the day, with 15 minutes in between for cleaning. Times for use of Fitness open to public are: 9:00, 10:15, 11:30, 12:45, 2:00, 3:15 & 4:30
    - TRC staff will monitor the fitness center
  - o The Boxing Floor will be open for use
    - Between the hours of 9-6 only.
    - (4) limited capacity only
    - The patrons using the Boxing Floor will be required to wear ppe and maintain social distancing at all times.
  - Our front offices will be open for the public
    - Only 1 patron is allowed in the front office at a time
    - Only 2 patrons can remain in the lobby at one time but must exercise social distancing practices
    - We will only accept credit and debit cards. No cash.
  - The Hub, Gymnasium, All activity rooms and the Bears Den will remain closed
  - We will continue to clean and sanitize the building throughout the day, every day.

#### **Programs/Special Events**

- All Programs/Special Events remain either canceled and/or postponed until Phase IIII. All programs and events will be open for business once we enter Phase IIII, which will be no earlier than June 15.
  - All programs and events, if opened, will be adjusted based off guidelines from the state.

## Phase IIII - Will open no earlier than June 15

#### **Parks**

Same as Phase III

#### **Recreation Center**

- Everything will be the same as Phase III except:
  - o Building will open from 9-7 with all amenities below.
  - o Fitness Center will allow (6) Capacity, open time 9-7, same 1-hour rotations
  - o Boxing Floor will allow (10) Capacity, open time 9-7
  - Wellbeats room will open but will allow only 2 people at a time
  - o Bears Den will be open for programming
    - Between hours 9-7
    - Only (8) capacity
  - o The Hub will remain closed
  - o The Gymnasium will be open for programming
    - Between hours 9-7
    - Only (10) capacity
  - o All other activity rooms will be open for programming
    - Between hours 9-7
    - Only (5) capacity
