Questions and Answers

- 1. Will the City allow pre-fab shelters rather than site built one?
 - Prefer site built
- Do the footings need to be outside or inside of the concrete pad?It will depend on what your engineer says when you have the plans drawn up
- 3. What roof design you had in mind for these structures, gable or sloped roofs.
 - Please attachment A (photo). They are gable sloped roofs. The large shade structure counts as two shade structures.
- 4. The bid requirement lists a performance bond to be included within the response, however would the requirement be a bid bond or bond ability letter instead?
 - A bond ability letter will be fine, if awarded then a bid bond would be required.
- 5. Is there a bid bond requirement for this job?
 - Yes, if awarded the job, a letter of bond ability will be acceptable for the bid response.
- 6. Do you have any drawings or ideas of what kind of shade structure you would like?
 - See attachment (photos) A, B & C
- 7. Are all 7 of the new structures the same size and style?
 - Yes, all approximately 15' X 20' with one double shade structure that consist of two 15' X 20' next to each other (attachment A) $^{\prime}$

9. Are you open to a bolt together system instead of welding?

No, welded only

10. Is there a color already selected?

Only what is stated in the RFP, existing concrete slabs stay in place. Refer to attachments (photos) A, B & C.


13. Can we make the footings square shaped instead of round?
