

The City of Two Harbors is working to complete an inventory of all service lines within the water system. The goal of the inventory is to identify the material type of each service line to create an action plan for removal of all lead service lines in the future.

Types of Water Pipes

LEAD

A dull, silver-gray color that is easily scratched with a coin. Use a magnet to detect the material – strong magnets will not cling to lead pipes.



GALVANIZED

A dull, silver-gray color. Use a magnet to detect the material – strong magnets will typically cling to galvanized pipes.



COPPER

The color of a penny.



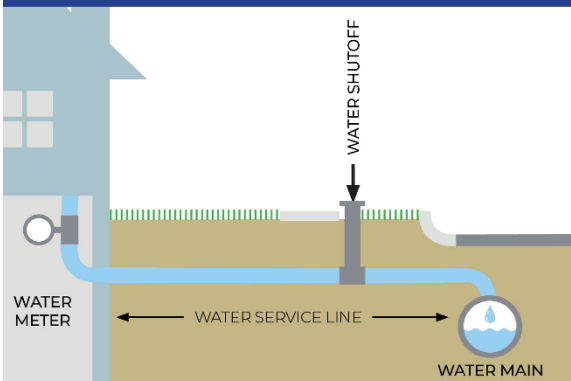
PLASTIC

Blue or black pipe.
