*** A mechanical plan review, including fire suppression plan reviews, are billed at \$80 per hour and are based on the inspectors hours billed for the review. All fees must be paid prior to permit being issued.**

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION:

GENERAL: Mechanical work shall not be started until a permit has been obtained. All installations shall be in conformance with the Mechanical Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.

When ready for an inspection, call the Township providing as much advance notice as possible. The Township will need the job location and permit number. When ready for an inspection, call the Township with as much notice as possible.

EXPIRATION OF PERMIT: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within six (6) months after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of six (6) months after the time of commencing the work. A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX (6) MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE, OR THE DATE OF THE LAST INSPECTION. CANCELLED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED OR REINSTATED.
