Connecting to your case with an Indiana Courts account:

You requested a case access code from mycase.in.gov to connect to your case as a party. You should have received your access code in the mail or at the clerk's office. You have 21 days from the date your access code was requested to enter your code on MyCase.

To use your access code, you will need an Indiana Courts account.

Step 1: Go to <https://m.in.gov/SignUp> to create your free Indiana Courts account and sign in.

Step 2: Go to <https://m.in.gov/MyCases> and enter your access code.

After entering your access code, you will have access to documents available to parties on your case. Remember, your access code will only give you access to documents on this case, not all cases you may be a party to. Your access code will connect you to your case for 180 days.
