Entry times and dates: Exhibits will be received from 12-6pm on Tuesday of Fair and 9am-12pm on Wednesday of Fair Week. **Entries** can be entered by Email to (fairoce@wasco.or.us) Call or text Superintendent for additional information. **Sunday of Fair.** Entries will be released starting at 3pm and ending at 5pm. Exhibitors may pick up their award monies on Sunday 12-5pm. Any products not picked up by 5pm on Sunday will be discarded.

Judging will begin at 2pm on Wednesday

Exhibits are **OPEN to ALL Wasco County and Warm Springs Reservation residents.**

Only one entry per class per exhibitor.

Awards will paper stickers and if a ribbon is desired please ask the Superintendent when picking up your exhibit.

GRAIN: One gallon jars for grain exhibits will be furnished. Only grain produced this year will be eligible. Grain must be combine run and not re-cleaned. Exhibits are sieved and tested by the Judge.

Premiums: 1st—10.00 2nd-- \$5.00 3rd -- \$3.00

SHEAF OF GRAIN: Sheaves are judged for attractiveness and quality. Sheaves must be 18 inches from bottom head to the base of the sheaf, and the base should be even and about 3 inches in diameter at the butt.

Premiums: 1st --\$5.00 2nd-- \$3.00 3rd -- \$1.00

HAY: Exhibit a flake of Hay in Plastic bag.
