## **INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. THIS IS NOT A PERMIT. Your permit will be issued later. Once the application has been processed and the proposed facility site inspected, you will be assigned a Permit Number and a permit will be issued to you.
- 2. List the name of the applicant (individual or company), complete mailing address, daytime phone number, fax number if applicable, and the name of the contact person if the applicant is a company.
- 3. The location of the proposed work shall be identified by road or street name and address, or by milepost and direction from nearest road or intersection. For all applications, a legal description of the proposed location must be provided.
- 4. All road improvement permit applications shall include a location map and a set of plans or sketch detailing the proposed work. The plan or sketch shall include the type of proposed improvement, the length, and if any excavation work is necessary. All plans must clearly indicate if a pavement cut is requested as part of the improvement.
- 5. All road improvement permit applications must include a detailed traffic control plan. The traffic plan shall be approved by Wasco County prior to any work.
- 6. Attached to the permit application is a copy of the Road Improvement Permit Regulations. These regulations apply to all work to be performed and it is the applicant's responsibility to insure that all permit regulations and conditions are followed.

Failure to provide required information or attachments will delay permit application processing.
