Purpose:

To control the pet population of Whiteside County by implementing and enforcing the **510 ILCS 92/ Illinois Public Health Safety Animal Population Control Act**. Whiteside County Animal Control will implement a countywide program using fees following the guidelines of the state program.

Procedure:

- Accept applications from Whiteside County residents with proof of Food Stamp Program or Social Security Disability Insurance.
- Sign a consent stating they are the owner of the dog/cat.
- Must have proof of ID and residency.
- Pay the co-payment of \$15 to the veterinarian performing the services.
- Animal must be served by a participating veterinarian.
- All paper- work will be maintained for reporting to the state and county supervisory boards/agencies.
