## **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

### **Conrad Lane Update – Change Order from 6” DGA sub-base with Geotech fabric (\$15.50 per square yard) to 9” DGA sub-base with Geotech fabric (\$21.00 per square yard)**

Kim Crupper explained that Logan Murphy and Dean Stith originally wanted to put down 11” DGA sub-base with no Geotech fabric but to help keep the cost down the Geotech fabric would be kept and downgrade to a 9” DGA sub-base would be best for project.

### **NKU Roof – Building owned by City of Williamstown**

The mayor wanted to give a quick update that bids for the roof at the NKU Grant County Center came in at \$87,000. Mayor Christopher has written letters to the surrounding counties to see if he can get donations to help with the cost since the center is used by different schools in different counties.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

### **Castle Knoll Waterline Proposal – discussion**

Mayor Christopher just wanted to inform Council he was going to meet with the residents of Castle Knoll on June 1<sup>st</sup> to see if they would be willing to buy the material and the city do the work for the waterline. He will come back to Council with updates on the meeting and if the residents were willing to accept this offer.

### **GAC Rehab Project – Discussion**

Water Superintendent Timmy Beach was here to discuss the GAC Rehab Project. Mr. Beach explained to Council these absorbers have to be cleaned and redone every so many years. The one currently being used is time to have the maintenance required and the city needs to fill one of the new ones. Division of Water that is regulated by EPA has new testing that will be done for PFAS and the absorbers need to be working properly in order to not be fined by State. The City of Williamstown has no choice in this and will have to follow EPA guidelines.

Superintendent Timmy Beach was told that \$20,000 should have been put back each year since the water plant was constructed for this expense. Mayor Christopher said they can get with City Clerk Vivian Link in the next budget meeting to make sure the money is there for the maintenance.
