GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Health and safety of our students and staff

Fair and equitable access to highquality instructional programming for all students



CURRENT SITUATION

- Promises were made to the community that cannot be met
- The current plan for the community cannot be implemented

Imperative to make changes immediately to ensure all students receive <u>quality instruction</u>



VALUES

- > We value:
 - Equitable education for <u>ALL</u> students
 - High-quality instruction with Williamsville teachers
 - Consistent connection for each student with his or her school community <u>five days a week</u>
 - Access to all of our programming for all of our students



We need to take a step back in order to move two steps forward."



INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL

- Elementary School
 - K-4 model remains the same for both hybrid and fully remote online learning

- District self-contained classes
 - **▶**8:1, 12:1, 15:1
 - In-person instruction five days a week



NEW INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL

Middle School and High School (5-12)

TEMPORARY FULLY REMOTE ONLINE LEARNING



STRENGTHS OF NEW MODEL

- All students will learn with existing high-quality Williamsville teachers from their schools
- All students will be able to have the same rich opportunities to participate in all courses
 - **Electives**
 - Accelerated Classes
 - ► SUPA Programs
 - Advanced Placement
 - Project Lead the Way
 - ► Academic Supports



STRENGTHS OF NEW MODEL

- This model provides fully synchronous, high-quality instruction for five days
- Current calendar allows for 180 days of instruction
- Seamless transition in case NYS directs districts to close



NEXT STEPS

- We are committed to bringing students back in building when we can provide the same level of full programming while meeting the regulations set by the State
 - Target date: November 16, 2020 (Grades 5-6)
 - Target date: January 4, 2021 (Grades 7-12)
- Community updates on bringing students back into the building
