

SCHOOL SOCIAL WORK - Nancy D. Fultz LCSWR 716-626-8676

School social work services are available to all students and their families in the Williamsville School District. As a School Social Worker in the Williamsville School District, I am excited to meet and work with the children and families at Heim Elementary School. Together we can make a difference.

The following services are available at Heim Elementary:

Consultation and Referral – Parents who have concerns regarding their child's adjustment at home or in school can discuss their concerns confidentially and will be assisted in developing a plan or in locating an appropriate community resource.

Individual Counseling – Counseling services are usually provided on a short-term basis and are designed to assist children in their school adjustment. Referrals can be made by teachers, parents, or the Child Support Team (CST).

Support Groups – The following support groups may be offered this year at various grade levels:

- Banana Splits (students dealing with separation or divorce)
- Cooperative Play
- Conflict Resolution
- Positive Peer Interaction (Friendship)
- Stress Management
- Self-Esteem / Self-Confidence
- Organizational Skills



Children may be referred by parents, teachers, or the CST. Support groups are developed based on referrals and student needs.

Primary Project – Primary Project is a school-based early intervention and prevention program. It is designed to develop skills to improve school success and reduce social, emotional and school adjustments that children may experience in kindergarten and first grade.

New York State Dignity for All Students Act

The goal of the Dignity for All Students Act (DASA), which took effect July 1, 2012, is to provide students with a school environment free of discrimination and harassment by peers and by school personnel. It applies to behaviors on school property, in school buildings, on a school bus, as well as at school-sponsored events or activities. Incidents of harassment and discrimination may include, but are not limited to, threats, intimidation or abuse based on a person's actual or perceived race, color, weight, national origin, ethnic group, religion, religious practice, disability, sexual orientation, gender (including gender identity or expression), and sex. These eleven categories are referred to as protected classes. In addition, amendments to the regulation (effective July 1, 2013) have added explicit references prohibiting bullying and cyber bullying.




PIC-TASTIC OPPORTUNITY: Attention Parent Photographers!



The power of the PTA comes from members like you. The more members we have means the louder our voice is and the more likely it is that kids and education are front and center in legislators' minds.



In September we're looking for people to help at the Wellness Picnic on September 8, to become cafeteria volunteers, to become library volunteers, and to help at Picture Day on October 2.


Also, please come to PTA's first meeting on September 18. We'll be having a fun event for your kids during the meeting, so please bring your whole family!






