

HOW TO EDIT AIRDROP SETTINGS



ADVANCED PLACEMENT SCHOLAR AWARDS

A total of **148** Williamsville North High School students have been named AP Scholars by the College Board in recognition of their exceptional achievement on the college-level Advanced Placement (AP) Examinations.

Students took AP Examinations in May of 2022 after completing challenging college-level courses at their high school. The College Board recognizes several levels of achievement-based student performance on AP exams. At Williamsville North High School:

- 48 students qualified for the AP Scholar Award by completing three or more AP Examinations, with grades of 3 or higher.
- **34** students qualified for the *AP Scholar with Honor Award* by earning an average grade of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, and grades of 3 or higher on four or more these exams.
- 66 students qualified for the AP Scholar with Distinction Award by earning an average grade of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and grades of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams. These students are:
- Of this year's award recipients, 96 are graduates of the class of 2022, 44 are currently in grade 12, 8 are currently in grade 11.






