Become A Member of the Neighborhood Advisory Committee ("NAC")!

The Board of Directors for Windsong Ranch Community Association, Inc. ("WRCA") has approved the creation of a Neighborhood Advisory Committee, or NAC with the purpose to become educated on community association law, specific community matters, provide homeowner recommendations, feedback, homeowner-based insight, provide problem solving efforts, professional expertise, and new ideas while assisting with communication and interaction between the Board of Directors, Community Association Staff ("Management"), the Developer, or other people or businesses who impact Windsong Ranch.

As a member of the NAC you:

- Will ensure that accurate and quality information is available for all homeowners to ascertain.
- Must attend meetings and committee educational opportunities.
 - At a minimum, but no more than bi-monthly.
- Must strive to accomplish tasks assigned by the Board or Management and make recommendations to the Board of Directors for a vote.
- Must be interested in community governance and understanding.
- Would be required to attend a "What it means to be a NAC Member" presentation.
- Will communicate with the community.
- Will be appointed for a 2-year term.

A Charter outlining the overall responsibilities of a committee member is located here or on the Windsong Ranch Community Website. We ask that all interested homeowners review the linked charter. Additionally, all interested homeowners shall complete the committee member application, located here.

The application process will be open and accepting applications until close of business on Friday, March 8. Beginning on March 16, after all applications have been reviewed, the Board of Directors will communicate with applicants to coordinate interviews for the three (3) to seven (7) open positions on the committee. Applicants will be informed of their status on the committee by March 31, 2024.

Once formalized, the announcement of members selected to serve on the committee will be announced to the committee and the education process of committee members will begin and the education and meeting schedule for 2024 will be communicated to those members.
