Water Vessel & Inflatable Parameters

The following parameters will be followed by Windsong Ranch Community Association and LAGOON staff to determine which water vessels and inflatables are allowed for use in THE LAGOON. Water vessels will receive a permit based on these parameters. Inflatables are not required to receive a permit but must follow the below guidelines.

Water Vessels

Water vessels are water borne vessels that have a propulsive capability and are used for active recreation and performance. In THE LAGOON, paddles and oars are the only two devices allowed for propulsive use. Motorized water vessels and vessels with pedal or rudder systems are not allowed for use. No part of the submerged vessel can contain metal components or sharp edges that could damage the liner of THE LAGOON.

The only types of water vessels allowed to be used in THE LAGOON are kayaks, stand up paddleboards (SUPs), and inflatable canoes. Along with following the manufacturer's weight capacity and occupancy limit, water vessels must follow the respective size and occupancy limits set by the HOA.

Inflatables

Inflatables include, but are not limited to pool floats, loungers, and tubes. Child swimming aids can be used in the beach areas; these can include arm bands, vests, tubes, belts, or any combination thereof. Inflatables' whose primary purpose is *not* for the assistance of a child's ability to swim *cannot* be used in the beach areas.

Inflatables' primary purpose must be for relaxation and leisure in order to be used beyond the buoy lines. Inflatables whose active use requires standing, climbing, jumping, or crawling may not be brought into THE LAGOON by residents. Inflatables must be no larger than 72 inches in *any* dimension and cannot exceed the occupancy limit of 2 adults or 4 children. Inflatable coolers or inflatables with built-in coolers are not allowed in THE LAGOON water.

Kayaks
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1, 2, and 2 and a half-seat kayaks are allowed to be used• Single kayaks must not exceed 12 ft. in length• Tandem kayaks must not exceed 14 ft. in length• Can be sit-on OR sit-in
Stand Up Paddleboards
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be no longer than 14 ft. in length• Must have a leash that is worn at all times while in use
Inflatable Canoes/Kayaks
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1, 2, and 3-seat inflatables are allowed to be used• Single seat vessels must not exceed 12 ft. in length• Tandem vessels must not exceed 14 ft. in length
