WHEREAS, the surplus property is valued as listed in Exhibit A;

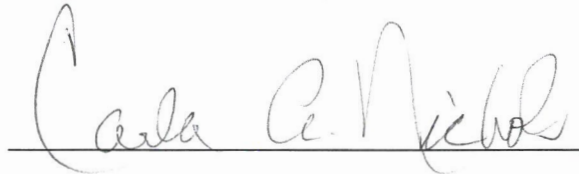
NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Woodway does hereby resolve as follows:

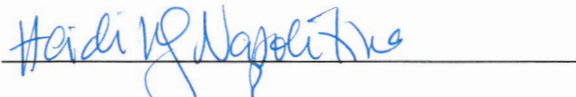
