Section 1. The items identified in Exhibit A are hereby declared surplus and shall be sold or disposed of.

Section 2. The Clerk-Treasurer, under the supervision of the Mayor, may dispose of these items in a reasonable fashion. If the item has a cash value, staff should make an effort to sell them for the market value.


