RESOLUTION 2021-427

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL FOR THE TOWN OF WOODWAY
REPEALING RESOLUTION 2020-420 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE MAYOR TO UTILIZE
THE EMERGENCY POWERS GRANTED UNDER CHAPTER 2.36 WOODWAY
MUNICIPAL CODE AND CHAPTER 38.52 RCW.

WHEREAS, on February 29, 2020, in response to new cases of COVID-19, the Governor of the State of Washington declared by Proclamation (20-05) that a State of Emergency exists in all counties in the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, by Health Officer's Order No. 20-056, the Snohomish County Health Officer proclaimed a countywide public health emergency for COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2020-420 authorized the mayor to utilize the emergency powers granted under Chapter 2.36 Woodway Municipal Code and Chapter 38.52 RCW; and

WHEREAS, Washington State and Snohomish County have made significant progress in the fight against COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Governor Inslee announced that, effective 12:01 AM on June 30, all industry sectors previously covered by guidance in the Healthy Washington – Roadmap to Recovery or the Safe Start Reopening Plan may return to usual capacity and operations, with limited exceptions for large indoor events.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Woodway does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. The COVID-19 virus no longer constitutes an emergency as defined by the Town of Woodway Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan and no longer necessitates the use of emergency powers granted under RCW 38.52.070.

Section 2. Resolution 2020-420 is hereby repealed.


