First Order of Business: Roll Call of Members
Second Order of Business: Approval of the Minutes of Meeting 1-22/23 held July 21, and Special Meeting 2-22/23 held August 4, 2022.

Item No. 8: To hear the reports of the Council Chair, committees, delegates, liaisons and the Town Manager.

Item No. 9: To hold a public hearing and act upon issuance of a full-time malt, spirituous, and vinous liquor license to Garrison and Chop Stick.

Item No. 10: To hold a public hearing and act upon acceptance of funds gifted by the Village Improvement Society for the Old Meeting House (Hillside Street), Village Parks and beautification projects and cultural events and programming, and the Latchstring Park project.

Item No. 11: To hold a public hearing and to vote to authorize a lease and operating agreement between the Town of Yarmouth and the Yarmouth Historical Society for the Old Meeting House.
