Background: Each year, the Town Council awards The Latchstring Award to a resident who has contributed his or her time, effort, and concern for an extended and exemplary period for the benefit of the community. The honor derives its name from the town motto 'Our Latchstring Always Out', and is intended to acknowledge residents whose examples of citizenship and leadership keep Yarmouth a warm and welcoming community

At This Meeting: Council will vote on a resolution naming the recipient of this year's Latchstring Award. That award will be formally presented at the Annual Town Meeting, June 6, 2023 at Yarmouth High School's Performing Arts Center.

Item No. 80: To act upon the report of the Latchstring Park Task Force and to consider actions thereon.

Background: The Latchstring Park Task Force has a concept for renovating and beautifying the park at the southwest corner of West Elm and Main Streets, and raised \$350,000 in funds to implement the plan. A resolution has been prepared that directs the Town staff to submit the plan, with amendments (if any) to the Planning Board for review. The resolution also dissolves the Latchstring Park Task Force and authorizes the Town staff to contract and pay for the construction of the park improvements with funds granted or donated to the Town for this project.
