My name is Tom Kroh, Regional Director Site Acquisition and Deployment for Ubicquia, Inc. Having worked in the wireless industry for 29 years, I am very familiar with the challenges of meeting the 5G wireless needs of residents while maintaining the historic and aesthetic integrity of the town. Our team works closely with wireless operators and municipalities by providing a simple, scalable and innovative way to make existing streetlight infrastructure intelligent. Rather than building new towers or cell sites, we leverage existing streetlight infrastructure and our Ubimetro and Ubihub platforms to improve wireless connectivity, increase public safety, and bridge the digital divide.

To deploy these products, we work with municipalities to obtain attachment rights for their streetlights. Having long-term contracts with nearly 900 utilities and cities across the country and deep relationships with every major wireless operator, Ubicquia is well positioned to help municipalities monetize their existing assets while supporting its residents by improving connectivity and/or public safety.

Benefits to the Town/Muni:

- Utilize Existing Streetlight Assets for non-traditional revenue generation
- No out-of-pocket expenses for the Town/Muni
- Ubicquia is single point of contact for parties interested in attaching to Town/Muni streetlights
- Minimizes burden on Town/Muni personnel

Objective: Deploy Ubicquia products, while helping the Town/Muni drive new non-traditional revenue across existing streetlight assets. Ubicquia will work with the Town/Muni to establish a mutually agreed upon Master Attachment Agreement that will allow **NON-EXCLUSIVE** access to the existing streetlight NEMA socket.



For every streetlight Ubicquia utilizes, the Town/Muni will be paid \$360/year. We anticipate utilizing as many as 200 streetlights over a five-year period. **Potential annual revenue for the Town/Muni could be \$72,000/year:**
