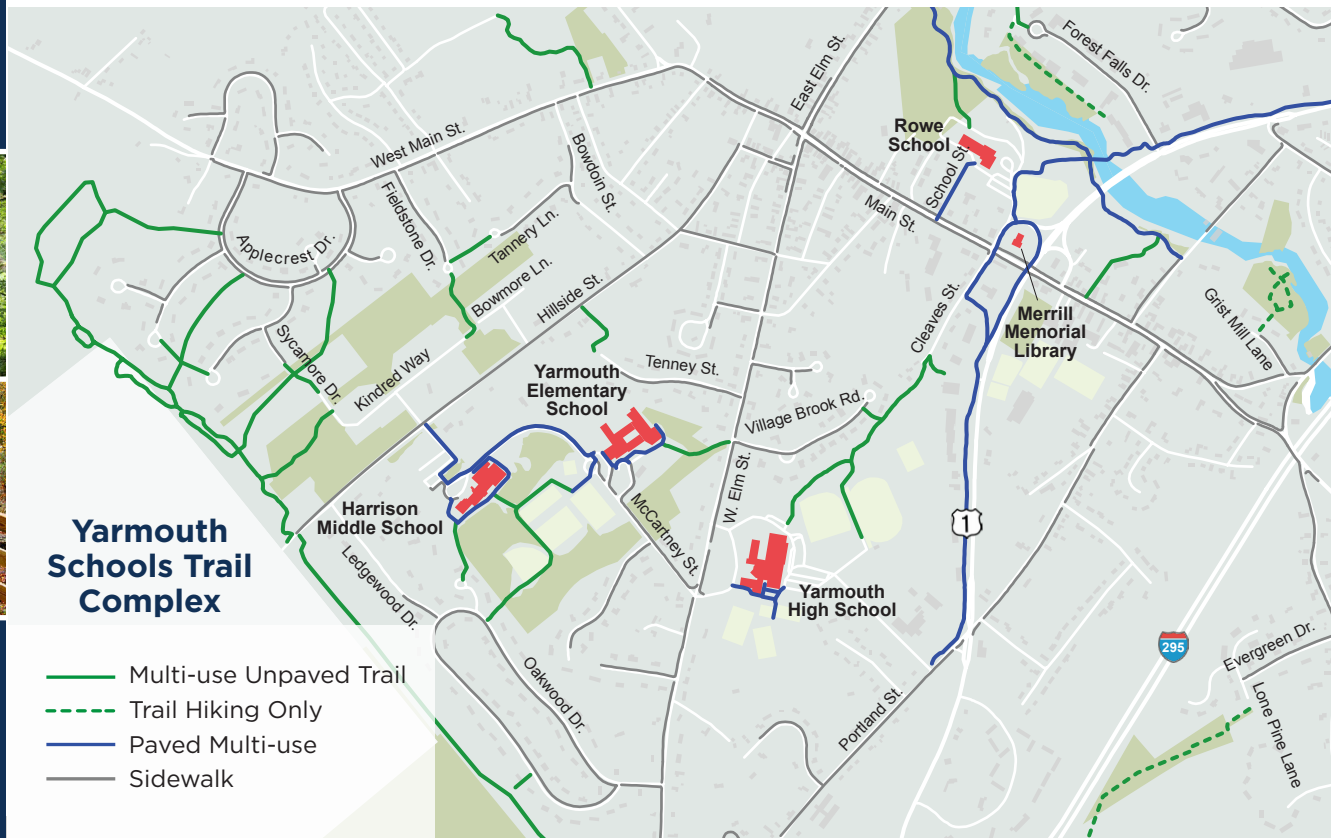


# TRAIL MAP



Yarmouth's sidewalks, quiet streets, and off-road paths are part of what makes this such a special and foot-friendly place to live. In order to enjoy the trails safely, follow these 4 tips:

1. Go in groups.
2. Plan your routes.
3. Don't ride or walk distracted (and make sure to make eye contact with drivers when crossing streets so you know they see you).
4. Give a heads up as you pass others in order to be heard, seen, and polite.

### KNOW YOUR RIDE:

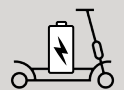
Certain rides have different rules



Non-motorized Bicycles



E-Bikes: Must be 16 years old or older. \*Certain types have different rules. Learn more at: [www.bikemaine.org/e-bikes](http://www.bikemaine.org/e-bikes)



Motorized Scooters: Must be 16 years old or older and have a valid driver's license.



Electric Personal Assistive Mobility Devices (includes hoverboards, E-skateboards, E-unicycles, etc.): Must not exceed speeds of 5MPH on sidewalks and 15MPH on public ways and bike paths.

### KNOW THE RULES OF THE ROAD:



#### RIDING ON SIDEWALKS

You can ride your bike on the sidewalk, but you need to be careful. Always watch out for people walking, let them go first, and say "Excuse me!" or ring your bell if you're coming up behind them.



#### FOLLOWING THE ROAD RULES

Always yield to pedestrians, and ride in the direction of traffic and to the right of the roadway. Stop at all red lights and stop signs. If you're coming out of a driveway, let cars go first before entering the road.



#### USING HAND SIGNALS

If you're turning or stopping, you must signal when turning or coming to a stop to show drivers and other riders what you're doing.



#### LIGHTS AND SAFETY GEAR

If you're riding at night, you must have a white front headlight and a red reflector or tail light on the back. Use additional reflectors on pedals, ankles, or tires. If you're under 16, state law requires you to wear a helmet when riding a bike.



#### MOPED AND MOTORCYCLE RULES

If you're under 18, you must wear a helmet on a moped or motorcycle. You need a special license and insurance for mopeds and motorcycles.

### RIDE SAFELY!

When traveling by e-bike, e-scooter, hoverboard or e-skateboard, be kind to people moving slower than you, and be seen by drivers. Riders can be fined and devices impounded for violations.

**1 Beth Condon Memorial Pathway, 1.68 mi**

**Path condition:** Mostly flat, paved, shared use path  
**Access:** Multi-use path spans Route 1 from Portland Street to East Main Street.  
**Bike Racks:** Rte 1 and Town Hall, Rte 1 and Hannaford/Southbound Metro Bus, Rte 1 and Portland St.

**2 West Side Trail, 10.8 mi**

**Path condition:** Unpaved trail with variable conditions  
**Access:** Parking lot behind Tyler Technologies office (1 Tyler Dr) at the trailhead, or accessed at various points across town under the CMP power line corridor.  
**Bike Racks:** Exit 15 Park n Ride Lot/Metro Bus Stop and Sandy Point Beach trail kiosk

**3 Royal River Park, 0.75 mi**

**Path condition:** Paved, shared use path with slight hills.  
**Access:** Parking lot on East Elm Street by Yarmouth History Center, via the BCMP at School Street and Rowe School parking lot, and on Bridge Street at the history sign.  
**Bike Racks:** Rowe School on School St. and off East Elm St. parking lot by the YCS garage.

**4 \*Pratt's Brook Park, ~6 mi**

**Path condition:** Unpaved networks of trails with varying conditions and crossings. Maps are posted at the North Road and Berryfield Road trail entrances.  
**Access:** Parking lot at 481 North Road, an entrance on Ledge Road at Mountfort Road, and an entrance at the end of Berryfield Road off of Granite St. **No bike racks.**

**5 \*Sweetsir Farm Preserve, 0.5 mi**

**Path condition:** Narrow, unpaved trail with mostly solid footing.  
**Access:** Small parking lot at Old Field Road off of North Road. **No bike racks.**

**6 Fels-Grove Farm Preserve, 58 acre**

**Path condition:** Unpaved trail in woods and mowed meadow path  
**Uses:** Hiking, dog walking, cross country skiing. Biking permitted only at connection to the West Side Trail.  
**Access:** Parking lot on south side of Gilman Road. Small woodlot west of the parking lot along Gilman Road has an accessible loop trail.  
**Bike Racks:** By trailhead kiosk.

**7 \*Riverfront Woods Preserve, 1.25 mi**

**Path condition:** Unpaved universally accessible trail through woods and marshes. Side trails are narrow and have very uneven trail treads.  
**Access:** Enter via the small parking lot at the end of Riverfront Drive (a new street off East Elm St. near its intersection with North Rd).  
**Bike Racks:** By trailhead kiosk.

**8 \*Frank Knight Forest, 1.9 mi**

**Path condition:** Unpaved loop trail  
**Access:** Trailhead at Yarmouth Community Garden on East Main Street. **Bike racks:** Near parking lot.

**9 Littlejohn Island Preserve, 1.3 mi**

**Path condition:** Unpaved and largely flat, wide, dry and well-maintained trail. Inner loop is relatively accessible for rugged strollers, walkers and the most rugged wheelchairs.  
**Access:** Small parking area at 180 Pemasong Lane, just before stone gate with "private" sign on it.  
**Bike Racks:** At trail entrance off Pemasong Lane.

\*Seasonal hunting and fishing are allowed in some of Yarmouth's open spaces by permit. Keep yourself safe during hunting season by wearing Blaze Orange, staying on marked trails or pathways, and using extra caution at dawn or dusk. Hunters must register online or at Yarmouth Town Hall.
