

**TOWN COUNCIL WORKSHOP AGENDA

**1st Order of Business:** To open the meeting to a public comment period.

**Item No. 1:** To hear the reports of the Council Chair, committees, delegates, liaisons and the Town Manager.

**Item No. 2:** To consider issuance of a full-time malt, spirituous and vinous liquor license and Special Amusement permit to each of the following establishments: Dandelion Catering and 233 Grill

**Item No. 3:** To consider improvements to the transfer station and recycling center to provide for a PAYT waste system.

**Background:** Last year Council appropriated \$770,000 to make necessary upgrades at the Transfer Station, and implement a PAYT program. Since that time, newer cost estimates for the project have come in higher. At Councilors' request, engineering work on the project has been paused and redirected so that staff can work on tweaking the project, to bring project costs closer to the prior estimate. Council discussed project alterations at Operations Committee and Town Council meetings last month.

**At This Workshop:** Council will continue discussion of the issue, and decide whether to schedule a vote.

**Item No. 4:** To consider amendments to Chapter 407 of the Yarmouth Town Code (Fire and Emergency Medical Services Fees Ordinance).

**Background:** Fire- Rescue Chief Mike Robitaille has requested that Council increase the Emergency Rescue Fees, which are significantly below the rates in Cumberland, North Yarmouth, Falmouth, Gray, York, Kennebunk, and other surrounding towns. Delivery costs have increased annually, and the last fee increase was 5 years ago.

**At This Workshop:** Council will decide whether to schedule a vote on the issue.

**Item No. 5:** To establish a budget review schedule for FY 21 (subject to revisions, as needed).

**Background:** The Council will begin discussing the 2020-2021 budget at a series of workshops in the months ahead.

**At This Workshop:** Council will schedule these workshops.

**Item No. 6:**

To consider or schedule other Council initiatives and requests as may be offered or introduced.
