Item No. 78: To hear the reports of the Council Chair, committees, delegates, liaisons and the Town Manager.

Item No. 79: To hold a public hearing and act upon issuance of a full-time malt, spirituous and vinous liquor license and Special Amusement permits to Thoroughfare.

Item No. 80: To receive the 2020 Annual Report of the Trust Fund Committee and to schedule action thereon.

Background: The Town Council annually reviews and ratifies the work of the Trust Committee from the prior calendar year.

At This Meeting: Council will vote on the issue.

Item No. 81 To confirm the Town Manager's appointment of Erin Zwirko as Director of Planning and Development pursuant to Article III Section of the Yarmouth Town Charter.

Background: Director of Planning Alex Jaegerman retired earlier this month. After interviewing candidates to fill that position, the Town Manager has appointed Erin Zwirko as Director of Planning and Development, subject to Town Council approval. The Town Charter states that the Town Council must approve the hiring of all new department heads, so Council will vote on the appointment.

At This Meeting: Council will vote on the appointment.

Item No. 82: To hold a public hearing and act upon the recommendations of the Shellfish Conservation Commission regarding licensing allocations for 2021.

Background: Each year the Shellfish Conservation Commission recommends a certain number of licenses to be allocated for harvesters. The Commission is recommending no changes from the 2020 allocation allowances.

At This Meeting: Council will vote on the license allocation recommended by the Shellfish Commission.

Item No. 83: To hold an Executive Session, if needed, including consideration of the recommendations of the Appointments Committee.
